



February and March Safety Training Events

The Builders Exchange training calendar is off to a great start and we would like to invite you to participate in any and all of our offerings since we are committed to providing training to promote a safe and healthful workplace environment.

February 23rd, 7:30a.m. – 9:30a.m. **“What to Expect During an OSHA Inspection.”**

This course is designed for anyone who would like to better understand the OSHA inspection process, and what the employee/employer must do to comply when an OSHA inspector appears on a job-site. The instructor, Bill Carey, currently works for the Kentucky Labor Cabinet and was an OSHA inspector for six years. He has a wealth of knowledge to share and openly invites questions from the audience. This course is free to all participants.

February 29th, 7:00a.m. – 3:30p.m., & March 1st, 7:00a.m. – 11:00a.m. **“OSHA Construction Industry Outreach Training Course.”** This day and a half course is designed for workers, foremen, superintendents, etc. who need a basic understanding of identifying hazards in the workplace. The program provides 10 hours of instruction on OSHA regulations and hazard recognition. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive an OSHA 10-Hour Construction Outreach Training course completion card within 4-6 weeks. This course is offered by Bart Leist, President of Compass Safety, LLC. The fee for this day and a half course is \$125 per participant.

March 9th, 8:00a.m. – 3:00p.m., **“CPR/First Aid, Bloodborne Pathogen/ AED Course.”**

This course is designed to certify all participants to safely provide CPR as well as basic first aid in an emergency situation. This course also provides Bloodborne Pathogen training including the proper use of “universal precautions.” The course includes skills practices and testing to ensure all participants can successfully offer life-saving support, if necessary. An American Heart Association CPR/First Aid/BBP course completion card will be presented to each participant. The card is valid for two years for CPR and one year for Bloodborne Pathogen. The fee for this one day course is \$85.00 per participant.
